

## How to connect NHS Laptop to Wireless Network

1. Click on the WIFI find icon on the lower-right corner of the Laptop screen next to date and time.



2. Under list of WIFI, Look for Firefly Network, Click on Connect, there is no password required.



3. Wait for the network to become **connected**.
