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Purpose

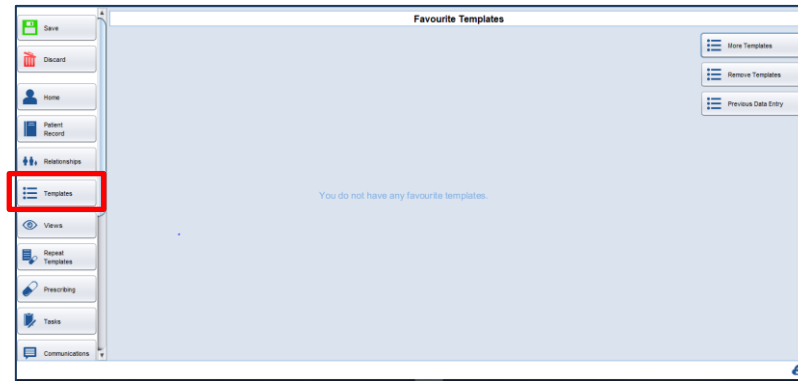
The purpose of this document is to support SystmOne Care Homes to setup of the UTI Template to send to your GP practice.

If the above template is not visible you will not be able to use the UTI Template. Below are the steps to do this.

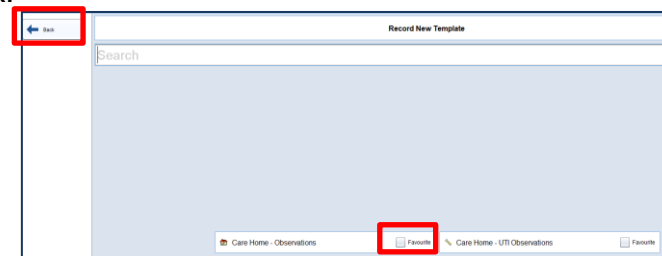
1. Retrieve the residents record then got to Templates on the left side bar.



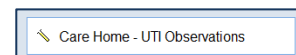
2. Click "More Templates" to the right.

 - Consider GP to measure for **adrenaline**
 - DO NOT PERFORM URINE DIPSTICK** - No longer recommended in gts >65 years.

CLINEX URINE - UTI highly unlikely
